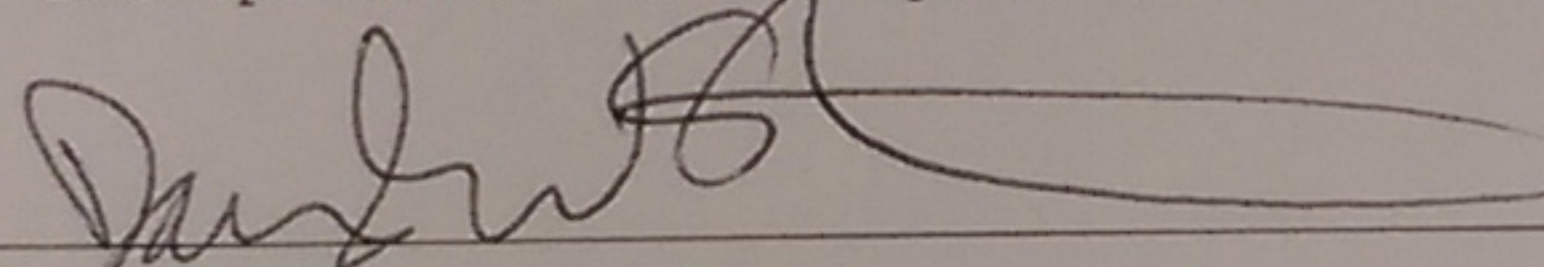

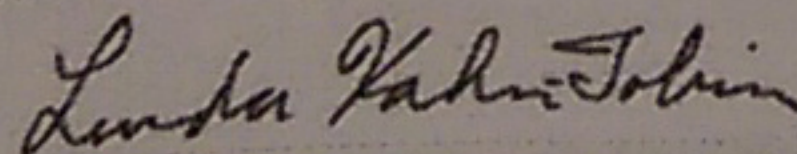

I authorize Mr. Finn to use our USDA import permit 54322 for this purpose.

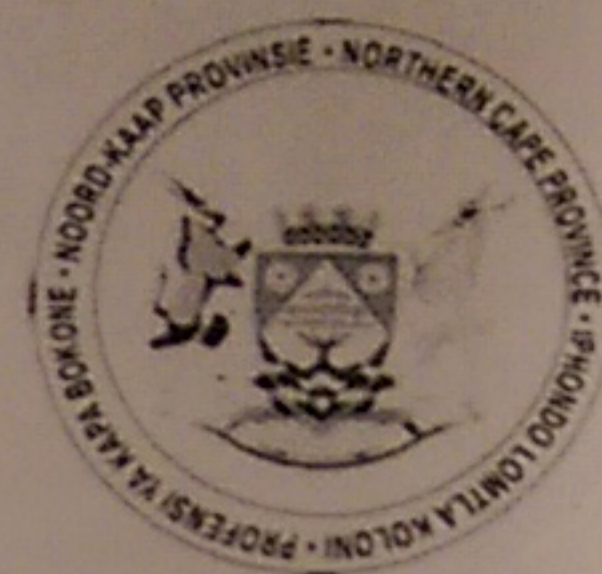

The number of samples that may be exported, such as blood and tissue samples is not limited as long as it is derived from not more than five (5) specimens.
- 2) It is imperative that all collected specimens and samples be frozen for a period before exportation to ensure that all pathogens are killed.
- 3) Collected specimens and samples may only be exported to and stored at the Florida Museum of Natural History in the USA.
- 4) Specimens of all species collected must be lodged at a South African Museum and the locality must be communicated to DENC.

7. Should a report, publication, article or thesis arise from this project, an acknowledgement to Department of Environment and Nature Conservation must please be included.
8. Unless otherwise specifically indicated in writing, no material or specimens collected with this permit or material or specimens bred or propagated, from material or specimens collected with this permit, may be donated, sold or used for any commercial purpose by any party.
9. Type-specimens of any newly described / discovered species or other taxon collected must be lodged with a recognized South African institution / museum / herbarium (preferably within the Province of the Northern Cape) where such material will be available to other researchers.

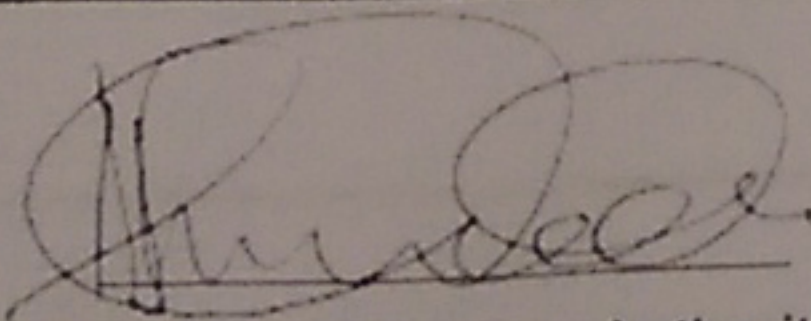

Only dead animals may be collected and no more than five (5) dead animals per species may be collected and/or sampled. The number of tissue and blood samples may be more than five (5) but may not have been collected from more than five (5) individuals.

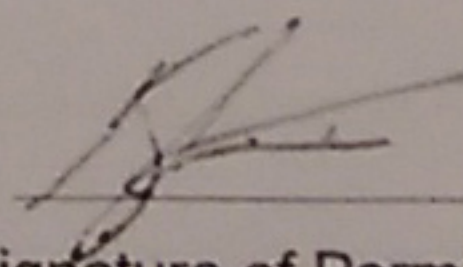
2) The collection of ive smaller reptile species (less than 100g) is limited to a maximum of two (2) specimens per species and no endangered fauna may be collected. This excludes the collection of already dead samples which is still limited to five (5) samples. Reptile specimens may only be collected by means of active search and capture and no traps of any kind may be set for capture.
