Disposition and Notes: This snake was basking along the main loop trail of the Deering main pinelands. Upon seeing the approaching NAM vehicle, the snake quickly retreated to a nearby gopher tortoise burrow. A second boa was also in this burrow, but the crew was unable to catch both, despite concerted efforts and use of Dallas' telescopic mini-camera. The second snake disappeared down a deep solution hole. Documentation of invasive species utilizing a protected natural area. No scars or ticks. This boa was midway through a skin shed at the time of collection.
